Ride the **Lewis & Clark Explorer Train** along the Oregon side of the lower Columbia River to Astoria. The train takes you close to several historic sites visited by the famous **L & C Corps of Discovery** expedition and includes passage through nature reserves and over river trestles. Sit back and relax in comfortable reclining seats. Enjoy panoramic views, through wide picture windows, of this scenic country traversed by Lewis & Clark.

The Lewis & Clark Explorer Train will operate Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday from **May 23 through Tuesday, Sept. 2, 2003**, when it makes its last run for the season. Portland-Astoria one-way adult train fare is **\$24**.

The picturesque <u>Astoria-Warrenton</u> region, was the most western outpost of Lewis & Clark and the Corps of Discovery and location of the oldest American settlement west of the Rockies. Once in Astoria, the Columbia River <u>Maritime Museum</u> is within walking distance of the station. The Astoria <u>Riverfront Trolley</u> provides convenient transportation along Astoria's working waterfront and historic downtown. <u>Sunset Empire Transit</u> links visitors to points of interest such as the Fort Clatsop <u>National Memorial</u>, Victorian-era <u>Flavel House</u> mansion and the Astoria Column.
